PAY RAISES FOR SENIOR DISTRICT JUDGES OF THE ELEVENTH CIRCUIT UNDER THE ETHICS RULE REFORM ACT OF 1989

Whereas, in order to be certified for salary increases, other than cost of living increases, to which Senior Judges are entitled under <u>28 U.S.C. § 371(b)</u>, they must perform judicial duties in an amount equal to or greater than the amount of work an average District Judge in the Eleventh Circuit performs in 60 days of judicial service during the calendar year; the Eleventh Circuit asked each Chief District Judge to establish a process within their district that enables the Chief District Judge to forward status reports to the Chief Judge of the Eleventh Circuit on a quarterly basis.

Therefore, all Senior Judges desiring to continue receiving the salary increases under 28 U.S.C. § 371(b) should schedule now to perform at least 60 days of judicial service during the calendar year 1991; and shall certify in writing to the Chief Judge of this District that they have complied with the above-mentioned Rules by the following dates during the 1991 calendar year:

> March 31, 1991 June 30, 1991 September 30, 1991 November 30, 1991
