IN THE FORT PIERCE DIVISION**


On Wednesday, November 20, 1991, at a regularly scheduled meeting of the judges of the Southern District of Florida, a report was presented to the Court by the Fort Pierce Case Assignment Committee in accordance with Administrative Order 91-68. Following discussion, the Court unanimously approved implementation of the following procedures with regard to the assignment of cases filed in the Fort Pierce division:

It is ORDERED and DECREED that effective January 1, 1992, civil and criminal cases filed in the Fort Pierce division be assigned to the judges listed below who have volunteered to receive Fort Pierce cases and try them in the Fort Pierce venue:

Chief Judge Norman C. Roettger
Judge James C. Paine
Judge James W. Kehoe
Judge Edward B. Davis
Judge William J. Zloch

It is further ORDERED and DIRECTED that any cases filed in the Fort Pierce division, between January 1, 1992 and the date of this order, and assigned to judges other than the five judges listed above, are to be re-assigned among the five judges designated herein to receive Fort Pierce division cases.
