IN RE: CHANGE OF CRIMINAL CASE CATEGORY, 90- 271-CR-MORENO U.S.A. V. BELLIZZI, et al.,

Pursuant to our blind random assignment system, the United States Attorney is to submit a Certificate of Trial Attorney simultaneously with the filing of a criminal indictment or information. This Certificate is used by the Clerk of Court to ascertain the category of each case for random assignment to the court. Judge Federico A. Moreno was randomly assigned 90-271-CR, originally filed in Criminal Category II. Trial time in this case exceeded 21 trial days, with an average of six hours per day, fulfilling the requirements for a Criminal Category IV case.

Therefore, the Clerk of Court is hereby directed to credit Judge Federico A. Moreno in Criminal Category IV, and debit in Category II.
