ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 93-77

IN RE: KAREN D. FAULKNER

On July 26, 1993, this Court upon consideration of the petition for reinstatement filed by Karen D. Faulkner pursuant to Rule IX, of the Rules Governing Attorney Discipline for the Southern District of Florida, denied Ms. Faulkner's petition without prejudice to later renewal upon the expiration of the five year period as provided under Rule IX.

Upon reconsideration of Ms. Faulkner's petition at the Judges' Meeting held on September 9th, 1993, Judge Moreno moved that the Order of July 26, 1993, denying her petition for reinstatement be vacated and that she be reinstated subject to verification that she had not been disbarred. The motion passed unanimously.

Therefore, it is hereby **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that the Clerk of Court is hereby to reinstate Karen Faulkner to this Court's Local Bar upon verification that in fact she has not been disbarred but suspended from the Florida Bar.
