SEALED MATTERS**

Upon consideration of the motion of the United States of America and pursuant to Administrative Order 93-27, this Court granted that certain materials currently in the custody of the Clerk of Court be unsealed solely for the purposes of examination by authorized employees of the United States Attorney's Office. Subsequently, the United States Attorney's Office for the Southern District of Florida issued a response, dated September 1, 1993, stating that, in their opinion, these materials should be disposed of according to Rule 6e of the Federal Rules of Criminal Procedure and the rules and regulation promulgated by the Administrative Office of the U.S. Courts.

It is therefore **ORDERED** and **ADJUDGED** that the Clerk of Court destroy those documents mentioned above and listed as Appendix A of this Order.
