ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 94-06

Upon consideration of the application for de novo review of disciplinary order entered by the Supreme Court of Florida and the emergency application to vacate order of disbarment and amended application for de novo review of disciplinary order entered by the Supreme Court of Florida, the court finds both applications should be denied.

Petitioner maintains this court's order of disbarment, Administrative Order 91-37, is null and void since he was not provided proper notice and an opportunity to be heard. He denies he received copies of either the disbarment signed May 9, 1991, or this court's order to show cause issued on April 11, 1991. Petitioner asks the court to vacate its disbarment order, reinstate the show cause order and, if necessary, refer the matter to the court or grievance committee for hearing.

The court has reviewed all documents in petitioner's file regarding his disbarment from this court and is satisfied that the petitioner was properly served with both orders. However, if petitioner did not receive said notices and orders from this court or correspondence from the Florida Supreme Court, the court finds petitioner moved without apprising the clerk of this court (or the Supreme Court of Florida) of his then current address.

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Mr. Grave's applications are DENIED. Petitioner's request for hearing is likewise DENIED.
