ABOLISHMENT OF NIGHT DEPOSITORY /

In light of the recent disaster in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, it is essential that security be increased around the perimeter of all federal buildings. Therefore, after-hours filings will no longer be permitted via the night depository boxes located at each divisional office of the Clerk of Court. In lieu of the current after-hours filing system, the Clerk of Court is hereby ordered to treat all pleadings filed before 10:00 a.m. as if they were filed on the previous business day and file stamp them accordingly. While the Court recognizes that this may create an inconvenience for our Local Bar, the Court feels that it has no alternative at this time but to move swiftly and surely to secure the Federal Courthouse complexes throughout the District.
