ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 95-35

IN RE:

HANDLING AND DESTRUCTION OF SEALED DOCUMENTS

At the request of the Clerk of Court, and after consultation with the United States Attorney's Office, it is agreed that all documents sealed prior to January 1, 1985 shall be unsealed and disposed of according to the Records Disposition Program included in the Guide to Judiciary Policies and Procedures (Volume I-B, Chapter IV, Part A). A list of these matters, by number, will be circulated by the Chief Judge to the Court and the United States Attorney's Office, advising that the listed documents shall be destroyed unless further action is taken.

Annually, on or about March 1st, the Court, on consultation with the Clerk of Court, and as directed by the Chief Judge of the Court, shall circulate a list of matters, by number, that have been sealed at the request of the United States Attorney's Office for ten years or longer, advising that office that the listed documents shall be destroyed unless further action is taken.

It is therefore ORDERED and ADJUDGED that the procedure outlined above will begin immediately.
