ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 95-70

IN RE:

HANDLING OF SEALED DOCUMENTS

All documents presented to a United States District Judge, or Magistrate Judge, of this Court related to electronic spryeillance including, but not limited to, applications and order pen registers, traps and traces, and an applications, affidavit and order requesting electronic surveillance pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 2510, et seq., shall be sealed on the application of the United States Attorney, his designee, or an attorney employed by the Department of Justice.

All such sealed matters shall be numbered and returned to the United States Attorney's Office, under seal, specifically to the Assistant United States Attorney making such application. All such matters shall be retained by the law enforcement agency in charge of the investigation, in the manner directed by the United States Attorney's Office and as required by law.

It is therefore ORDERED and ADJUDGED that the procedure outlined above will begin immediately.
