ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 96-10

IN RE:

CELLULAR PHONE USAGE IN THE COURTHOUSE

At the request of the Court, the Court Security Committee has reexamined the Court's current policy of allowing cellular phones in the various buildings that comprise Federal Judicial Complex throughout the Southern District of Florida. On consideration of the Court Security Committee recommendation, The Court approves and hereby orders that the District's current policy of allowing cellular phones in all Court facilities throughout the District be continued for an indefinite period of time.

The policy of prohibiting the use of cellular phones within the confines of all courtrooms <u>and jury rooms</u> will continue to be prohibited, and they shall be turned off at all times when inside said areas.

The United States Marshal's Service is to continue to inspect all cellular phones as they are brought into the building as directed to protect the Bench, Bar and Public from harm.
