**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 96-55** 

IN RE: MODIFICATION OF ASSIGNMENT OF MATTERS TO MAGISTRATE JUDGE SORRENTINO AND MAGISTRATE JUDGE SNOW

This is to modify Administrative Order 93-69 and 91-48 in connection with the assignment of all pro se prisoner petitions filed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2255 in this District.

At a regularly scheduled meeting of the Executive Committee of this Court, a discussion ensued regarding the continuing assignment of pro se 2255 cases to Magistrate Judge Lurana S. Snow. After consideration, the Executive Committee voted unanimously to change the present case assignment system to reflect that effective December 1, 1996, the assignment of all said cases shall be to Magistrate Judge Sorrentino.

Magistrate Judge Snow will keep her current caseload, including any pro se 2255 cases, assigned before December 1, 1996.

The half position pro se law clerk position is hereby assigned to Magistrate Judge Sorrentino, and the full time pro se law clerk position currently assigned to Magistrate Judge Snow will be transferred to Magistrate Judge Sorrentino effective March 31, 1997.

The Clerk of Court is hereby ordered to modify all procedures necessary to effect said change throughout the District.

In all other respects Administrative Order 93-69 shall remain in full force and effect.
