
IN RE:

PAYMENT TO GARNISHEE
OF DEPOSIT REQUIRED FOR ATTORNEY'S
FEES IN GARNISHMENT PROCEEDINGS

Pursuant to Rule 69 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Section 77.28 of the Florida Statutes, and Administrative Order 90-104, a party applying for the issuance of a writ of garnishment shall deposit \$100.00 in the registry of the Court. The deposit is for the attorney's fees of the garnishee. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that the Clerk of Court pay such deposit in any applicable civil case to the garnishee on the garnishee's demand at any time after the service of the writ for the payment or part payment of his or her attorney's fee which the garnishee expends or agrees to expend in obtaining representation in response to the writ.
