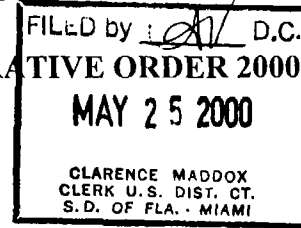

ORDER OF SUSPENSION
