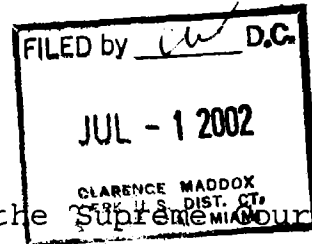

ORDER OF SUSPENSION


