Commencing August 1, 2003, procedures are hereby instituted to govern the establishment of restitution payment schedules prior and subsequent to the 11th Circuit decision in United States v. Prouty, 303 F.3d 1249, 1255 (11th Cir. 2002). Accordingly, it is hereby

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the restitution payment schedule procedures are as follows:

- 1. The Court approves all offenders with set payment schedules to continue making payments as previously agreed;
- 2. All new payment schedules, or changes to payment schedules, will be set by the Court through Probation Form 12B provided the offender waives their right to a hearing; and
- 3. Suspension of payment schedules for a period of ninety (90) days or less will not be considered as a change in schedule requiring a Court hearing.
