As prescribed by the Judicial Conference of the United States under its authority to set fees pursuant to 28 U.S.C. 1914(b), this Court hereby establishes a new attorney admissions fee of \$175.00. The new fee incorporates a \$100 increase approved by the Judicial Conference on March 16, 2004 with the fees established under Administrative Order 96-61 for admission to the Local Bar. This fee change becomes effective on June 1, 2004, and shall be paid by every attorney seeking admission to the Southern District of Florida's Bar on or after that date. The fee should be paid by check made payable to "U.S. Courts" and be accompanied by written application and certification as specified in our Local Rules. This fee increase does not apply to attorneys petitioning the Court to appear and participate in a particular case under Rule 4(B) of the Special Rules Governing the Admission and Practice of Attorneys in this District.
