It has been shown to the Court that the Supreme Court of Florida has disbarred the above-named attorney from practicing law in Florida, effective immediately following a December 18, 2003, order. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by this Court that the Clerk of Court mail Joseph Nathaniel Baron a copy of this Order of Disbarment.
