

ORDER OF SUSPENSION

IN THE MATTER OF JOHN LOUIS WALKDEN

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2005-17



It has been shown to the Court that the Supreme Court of Florida has suspended the above-named attorney from practicing law in Florida, effective thirty (30) days following a March 11, 2004, order. On June 9, 2004, Mr. Walkden was served by mail with an Order to Show Cause why this Court should not impose the same discipline, accompanied by the Supreme Court of Florida's Order of Suspension. As of the date of this Order, more than 90 days has passed with no response from Mr. Walkden. Pursuant to the Rules Governing Attorney Discipline, United States District Court, Southern District of Florida, it is ORDERED that said attorney be suspended from practice in this Court, effective April 11, 2004.
