

ORDERED that John J. O'Sullivan be appointed as full-time United States Magistrate Judge at Miami, Florida, at an annual salary as fixed by the Judicial Conference of the United States. It being further ORDERED that United States Magistrate Judge O'Sullivan shall commence performance of his duties on the 1st day of April, 2007, upon taking the oath or affirmation prescribed by Title 28, United States Code, Sections 453 and 631(g), and shall hold and discharge the duties of his office for a term of eight years from the date of this appointment, subject to the provisions of Title 28, United States Code, Section 631(e), unless sooner relieved.
