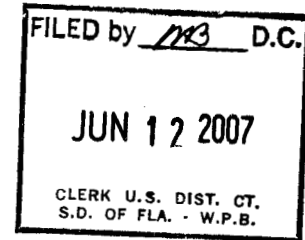


ORDERED that the following civil cases will be transferred to the Honorable CECILIA M. ALTONAGA forthwith:

9:07CV80208	Ledford v. Sterling Jewelers, Inc.

Magistrate Judge Linnea R. Johnson shall effect the transfer of those cases that are currently referred to her by certifying that all pending fully briefed motions have been resolved and ordering that the Clerk transfer the cases to Magistrate Judge William C. Turnoff, who is paired with Judge Altonaga. Those cases which are not referred may be administratively transferred to the new Magistrate Judge by the Clerk upon the direction of Magistrate Judge Johnson. The Clerk shall promptly execute the transfers to the new Magistrate Judge, and upon doing so shall immediately change the case's magistrate judge designation.

The Clerk's Office is directed to ensure that counsel of record in all transferred cases is notified of the transfer via the Court CM/ECF program.
