ORDER OF DISBARMENT

The Supreme Court of Florida has entered an Order of Disbarment dated October 8, 2009, disbarring this attorney from the practice of law effective *nunc pro tunc*, April 9, 2007. That Order of Disbarment was predicated upon a Disbarment on Consent entered between the attorney and the Florida Bar. Thereafter, the Clerk attempted service of an Order to Show Cause why reciprocal discipline should not be entered by way of certified mail to the attorney's court record and Florida Bar address.

Rule 6(b) of the Southern District of Florida Attorney Discipline Rules provides: "An attorney...who shall be disbarred on consent or resign from the bar of any other court . . . while an investigation is pending shall . . . cease to be permitted to practice before this Court and be stricken from the roll of attorneys admitted to practice before this Court." Under these circumstances involving disbarment on consent, service of an Order to Show Cause is unnecessary and the attorney may be immediately disbarred. Pursuant to Rule 6(b) and the inherent authority of this Court to oversee officers admitted to membership in its bar, it is

ORDERED that the above named attorney be disbarred from practice in this Court, effective immediately. The Clerk of Court shall strike this attorney from the roll of attorneys for the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida, and shall also immediately revoke his CM/ECF password.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by this Court that said attorney advise the Clerk of the Court

of all pending cases before this Court in which he is counsel or co-counsel of record.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by this Court that the Clerk of Court shall attempt to serve by

certified mail a copy of this Order of Disbarment upon the attorney at his court record address.
