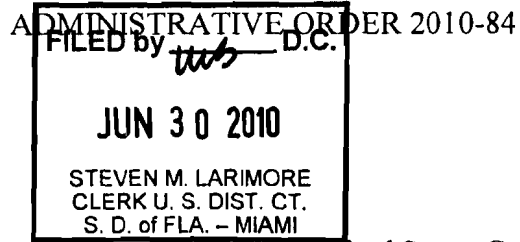

This matter is before the Court upon an order of the Eleventh Circuit United States Court of Appeals directing the Chief Judge of the Southern District of Florida to appoint a Special Master to make recommended findings of fact and conclusions of law regarding the National Labor Relations Board's petition for an adjudication in civil contempt against Palm Metro Transportation, LLC. After consideration, it is

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that the Court appoints Magistrate Judge Ann E. Vitunac as a Special Master with the authority, powers and duties set forth in the Eleventh Circuit's June 15, 2010 Order on Application for Enforcement of a Final Order of the National Labor Relations Board. Palm Beach Metro Transp., LLC., v. Nat'l Labor Relations Board, Case No. 08-13447-JJ. The Clerk of Court is directed to notify the parties once the Special Master issues her findings of fact and conclusions of law.
