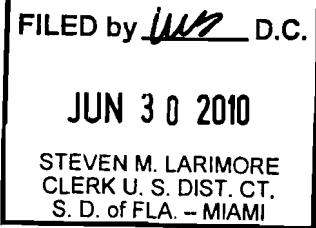

**IN RE: NARCOTICS SECTION CASE ASSIGNMENTS TO  
HONORABLE JAMES LAWRENCE KING**

Administrative Order 2000-45 entered on June 16, 2000, by then Chief Judge Edward B. Davis removed Judge James Lawrence King from the assignment of cases originating in the Narcotics Section of the United States Attorney's Office, where his daughter was employed as Chief of the Narcotics Section. Judge King's daughter is no longer employed in that position as Chief of the Narcotics Section and therefore, he requests assignment of those cases as well. Therefore, it is

**ORDERED and ADJUDGED** that Administrative Order 2000-45 is vacated. Judge King is to receive randomly selected cases as any other active District Judge.
