Rule 1 of the Southern District of Florida's Special Rules Governing The Admission and

Practice of Attorneys establishes as a prerequisite that attorneys take and pass an examination prior

to admission to this Court's bar. This District is only one of approximately four federal district

courts nationwide that requires an admission examination. At a regularly scheduled meeting of the

Judges of this District held on February 23, 2012, the Judges have determined that requiring a local

examination to a large degree duplicates matters found on the Florida Bar exam and no longer

accomplishes the purposes it was intended to serve. A substantial majority of Judges of this Court

have voted to eliminate Rule 1's examination requirement. Accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the examination requirement stated in Rule 1 of the

Southern District of Florida's Special Rules Governing The Admission and Practice of Attorneys

is hereby suspended, effective immediately. Attorneys who satisfy all other requirements for

admission to this Court's bar, and who have paid all required admission fees, shall be admitted to

the bar of this Court without the necessity of passing an examination; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of Court is directed to provide notice of this

Administrative Order through the CM/ECF noticing system and other appropriate means such as

publication, and to post revised procedures for admission to the Court's bar on the Southern

District's website www.flsd.uscourts.gov as soon as reasonably practicable.
