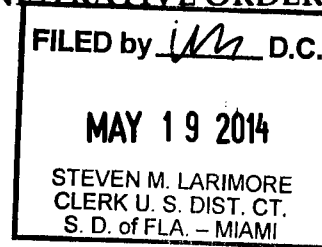

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2014-48

**In Re: Reassignment of District Judge
Robin S. Rosenbaum's Cases**



Due to District Judge Robin S. Rosenbaum's confirmation to the Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals, and pursuant to Sections 2.10.00 and 3.03.00 of the Internal Operating Procedures, it is herein

ORDERED that District Judge Robin S. Rosenbaum's pending civil cases (with the exception of Bankruptcy Appeals cases assigned through the Court's Bankruptcy Appeals wheel, which will be reassigned by separate order) will be randomly reassigned to active District Judges throughout the District. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that District Judge Robin S. Rosenbaum's pending criminal cases will be randomly reassigned to active District Judges giving priority to geographic locations; in other words, West Palm Beach criminal cases shall be randomly reassigned to West Palm Beach judges first, or secondarily to Fort Lauderdale judges; Fort Lauderdale criminal cases will be reassigned to Fort Lauderdale judges first, or secondarily to Miami judges; and Miami criminal cases will be reassigned to Miami judges. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that these civil and criminal case reassignments shall take place upon Judge Rosenbaum's notification to the Clerk's Office that individual cases are ready for transfer. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that any criminal cases that were tried before Judge Rosenbaum that are awaiting sentencing shall not be reassigned. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that the cases assigned shall exclude any that Judge Rosenbaum has notified the Clerk that she intends to keep while continuing to sit by designation with the Southern District. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that the Magistrate Judge on all transferred cases shall be administratively changed by the Clerk to the paired Magistrate Judge of the newly assigned District Judge. The newly assigned District Judges shall decide whether any previously referred matters shall be handled by their paired Magistrate Judge, or whether those previous referrals shall be terminated; it is

FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk's Office will make a notation on the docket of each case reflecting the fact that the case has been transferred upon the authority of this Administrative Order, and each counsel and *pro se* party of record will receive notification through the CM/ECF procedures or by mail. Because this Administrative Order is available for public viewing on the Court's website, a copy of this Administrative Order need not be docketed in each case.
