**IN RE: REASSIGNMENT OF DISTRICT JUDGE
ROBIN S. ROSENBAUM'S BANKRUPTCY CASES**

Due to District Judge Robin S. Rosenbaum's confirmation to the Eleventh Circuit Court of Appeals, and pursuant to Sections 2.10.00 and 3.03.00 of the Internal Operating Procedures, the Court entered Administrative Order 2014-48 directing the re-assignment of her cases, except for Bankruptcy cases assigned to her through the Court's Bankruptcy Appeals wheel. In light of Administrative Order 2014-57 abolishing that Bankruptcy wheel, it is hereby

ORDERED that District Judge Robin S. Rosenbaum's pending Bankruptcy Appeals cases will be randomly reassigned consistent with Administrative Order 2014-48 to those eleven active District Judges, who previously received Judge Rosenbaum's cases. It is

FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk's Office will make a notation on the docket of each case reflecting the fact that the case has been transferred upon the authority of this Administrative Order, and each counsel and *pro se* party of record will receive notification through the CM/ECF procedures or by mail. Because this Administrative Order is available for public viewing on the Court's website, a copy of this Administrative Order need not be docketed in each case.
