## **ORDER OF SUSPENSION**

On February 2, 2015, this Court issued an Order Directing Attorney to Update Contact Information and Keep the Court Apprised of The Florida Bar Inquiry that was the subject of his suspension by the Florida Supreme Court. *See The Florida Bar v. Getzinger*, 151 So. 3d 1229 (Fla. 2014). As of the date of this Order, Getzinger has not complied with this Court's February 2nd Order, which required him to acknowledge receipt of the Order, update his current contact information, and to inform the Court of The Florida Bar's investigation. A copy of the Order is attached.

Given this background and the Court's inherent power to regulate membership in its bar for the protection of the public interest, *see Chambers v. NASCO, Inc.*, 501 U.S. 32, 43 (1991) ("[A] federal court has the power to control admission to its bar and to discipline attorneys who appear before it."),

IT IS ORDERED that Getzinger be temporarily suspended pending compliance with this Court's February 2nd Order. The attorney may not resume the practice of law before this Court until reinstated by Order of this Court. *See* Rule 9, Rules Governing Attorney Discipline, Local Rules of the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida. The Clerk of Court shall strike this attorney from the roll of attorneys eligible to practice in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida, and shall also temporarily suspend the attorney's CM/ECF privileges.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by this Court that said attorney advise the Clerk of Court of all pending cases before this Court in which he is counsel or co-counsel of record.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED by this Court that the Clerk of Court attempt to serve by certified mail a copy of this Order of Suspension upon the attorney at his Florida Bar address.
