

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2016-28

In Re: Further Reassignment of Senior District Judge Kenneth L. Ryskamp's Civil Cases And Amendment to Administrative Order 2016-26



Senior District Judge Kenneth L. Ryskamp's remaining civil cases were reassigned to other Judges pursuant to Administrative Order 2016-26. Judge Kenneth A. Marra received 17 cases pursuant to AO 2016-26. He had previously received 21 civil cases from Judge Ryskamp pursuant to Administrative Order 2016-25. The Judges receiving Judge Ryskamp's cases did not contemplate that Judge Marra would receive additional reassignments beyond those designated in AO 2016-25. Given this background, and in order to better equalize the distribution of cases among Judges regularly receiving West Palm Beach civil case assignments, pursuant to Sections 2.10.00 and 3.03.00 of the Court's Internal Operating Procedures, it is herein

ORDERED that effective immediately, the 17 civil cases originally reassigned pursuant to Administrative Order 2016-26 to Judge Kenneth A. Marra, shall be reassigned as reflected in the attached listing, which was created by the Clerk's Office through a random selection process and provided to the undersigned for inclusion in this Order; It is

FURTHER ORDERED that the Judges who receive these cases shall receive case assignment credit equal to the number of cases assigned so as to equalize those Judges' case credits over time; It is

FURTHER ORDERED that the Magistrate Judge on all transferred cases shall be

administratively changed by the Clerk to the paired Magistrate Judge of the newly

assigned District Judge. The newly assigned District Judges shall decide whether any

previously referred matters shall be handled by their paired Magistrate Judge, or

whether those previous referrals shall be terminated; it is

FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk's Office will make a notation on the docket

of each case reflecting the fact that the case has been transferred upon the authority of

this Administrative Order, and each counsel and pro se party of record will receive

notification through the CM/ECF procedures or by mail. Because this Administrative

Order is available for public viewing on the Court's website, a copy of this

Administrative Order need not be docketed in each case.
