A vacancy will exist for the position of Chief United States Probation Officer upon the retirement of Chief Reginald Michael on June 30, 2017. The Court has determined that the appointment of an Acting Chief United States Probation Officer is appropriate until such time as a permanent Chief United States Probation Officer is selected. Further, the Court has unanimously voted to designate Chief Deputy United States Probation Officer Katherine Koonce as Acting Chief United States Probation Officer. Accordingly, it is hereby

ORDERED that Katherine Koonce is hereby appointed Acting Chief United States Probation Officer for the Southern District of Florida effective July 1, 2017. It is further

ORDERED that the Clerk will cause certified copies of this order to be entered upon the record of this Court, and shall forward a certified copy of this order and the appropriate documents of appointment to the Administrative Office of the United States Courts.

This Order supersedes Administrative Order 2005-52.
