ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2017-42

IN RE: CONSTITUTING MASTER JURY WHEEL



Pursuant to the provisions of the Jury Selection and Service Act of 1968, (28 U.S.C. 1861 et seq.), and subject to the provisions of the Jury Plan of the Southern District of Florida, which establishes the minimum number of names to be selected and allows for proportional representation of counties within each division for the creation of the Master Jury Wheel.

It is **ORDERED** that the Clerk shall randomly select and designate through a pure random and electronic process, or cause to be randomly selected and designated by these means, the names from the voters' registration lists of each county in accordance with the Plan, as follows:

It is further **ORDERED** that, under the direction and control of the Court, the Clerk of Court shall cause such names so designated to be extracted and recorded so as to constitute the Master Jury Wheel from which there shall be qualified and summoned in a single procedure for Grand and Petit Jury Service, all in compliance with the Plan.
