This matter is before the Court upon the recommendation of the Court's Ad Hoc Advisory Committee on Court Annexed Mediation. Based on the Committee's recommendation, it is

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that Administrative Order 2008-08 is superseded. It is further

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that, in cases where the parties have not agreed on the selection of a mediator which results in the Clerk of the Court designating a mediator on a blind, random basis under S.D. Fla. L.R. 16.2(d)(1)(B) after the date of this Order, such designated mediators shall be compensated at the rate of three hundred and fifty dollars (\$350) per hour, which includes the mediator's time preparing for and conducting the mediation, without compensation for travel.
