The Court voted in favor of amending the Court's unsealing procedures and rescinding the process of unsealing set forth in Administrative Order 2014-69, which applies to documents filed under seal prior to December 2, 2013. Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Administrative Order 2014-69 is rescinded.

The Clerk's Office shall continue to monitor the status of sealed and unsealed documents as set forth in the applicable orders to seal and consistent with the Local Rules for the Southern District of Florida.
