IN RE: ORDER VACATING ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2016-70, ELECTRONIC SUBMISSION OF EXHIBITS



On November 22, 2016, the Court entered Administrative Order 2016-70, entitled "In re: Electronic Submission of Exhibits." That Order was "intended to implement interim procedures to enable the Court to Comply with the Eleventh Circuit's new rules adopted effective December 1, 2016. . . . [and were to] remain in effect until such time as this Court's Local Rules Committee has had an opportunity to solicit input from the bar and propose permanent procedures for adoption by the full Court."

Upon review by the Committee and proposal to the Court, amendments to Local Rule 5.3 were adopted by Administrative Order 2017-60 on October 19, 2017, effective December 1, 2017. These amendments establish the permanent procedures for the electronic submission of exhibits in this Court that are in compliance with the Eleventh Circuit's new rules. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that Administrative Order 2016-70 is VACATED.
