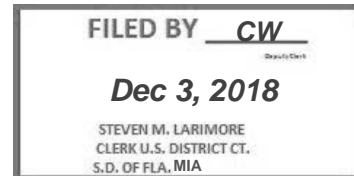

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2018- 92

**IN RE:  
NATIONAL DAY OF MOURNING FOR  
PRESIDENT GEORGE H. W. BUSH**

On December 1, 2018, President Donald J. Trump entered an Executive Order declaring a National Day of Mourning on Wednesday, December 5, 2018, to honor the memory of former President George Herbert Walker Bush, the forty-first President of the United States. Following the lead of the executive branch, the Supreme Court will be in recess and the Administrative Office of the U. S. Courts will be closed that day.


The Administrative Office of the U. S. Courts has indicated that “a chief judge as agency head may designate an additional day as a holiday (excused absence).” Typical examples include a day specially designated as a holiday by the President or the Congress of the United States, or by local court order. Excused absence for a holiday is granted only for a specific date. Based on the foregoing,

**IT IS ORDERED** that the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida, at all its Divisions including Probation, will be closed to the public on Wednesday, December 5, 2018. It is further

**ORDERED** that consistent with Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 77(a), the Clerk’s Office will follow established protocols for receipt and processing of filings which require emergency judicial attention. It is further

**ORDERED** that Wednesday, December 5, 2018, will be treated as a holiday for federal leave purposes pursuant to the President's Executive Order. The Court will reopen for normal business hours on Thursday, December 6, 2018.
