Pursuant to the Court's Internal Operating Procedures, Section 4.02.00, the District Judges may select one full-time Magistrate Judge to serve as the Chief Magistrate Judge performing administrative functions. The Court established a schedule to rotate the position of Chief Magistrate Judge based on seniority in March 1994. The term of Chief Magistrate Judge Andrea M. Simonton will expire upon her upcoming retirement effective January 4, 2019, and Magistrate Judge John J. O'Sullivan is next in line of seniority. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that Magistrate Judge John J. O'Sullivan is hereby appointed as Chief Magistrate Judge vice Magistrate Judge Andrea M. Simonton; it is

FURTHER ORDERED that Magistrate Judge O'Sullivan's appointment as Chief Magistrate Judge shall be for a three-year term effective the date of Judge Simonton's retirement on January 4, 2019.
