IN RE: AMENDED MAGISTRATE JUDGE PAIRING ASSIGNMENT PLAN

Administrative Order 2017-38 modified this Court's Magistrate Judge Pairing Assignment Plan effective August 1, 2017, until further ordered. Administrative Orders 2018-65 and 2019-5 modified the Magistrate Judge Pairing Assignment Plan. Due to the recent confirmation of United States District Judge Roy K. Altman, the Magistrate Judge Pairing Assignment Plan is amended as follows:

ORDERED that effective April 11, 2019, when Judge Altman begins receiving case transfers from other District Judges, he will be paired with Magistrate Judge Patrick M. Hunt for all Fort Lauderdale and Miami cases; and Magistrate Judge Dave Lee Brannon for all West Palm Beach cases: it is

FURTHER ORDERED that all matters referred prior to April 11, 2019, shall be disposed of by the Magistrate Judge paired with the transferring District Judge irrespective of whether the motion is "ripe" or not. If the case is referred for all discovery matters or referred in full, the Magistrate Judge must complete the work necessary to rule on the pending matters before there is a referral to the Magistrate Judge paired with Judge Altman.
