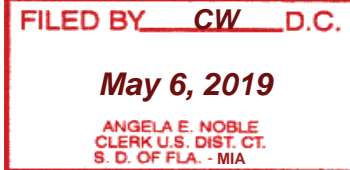

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2019-33

IN RE: AMENDED MAGISTRATE
JUDGE PAIRING ASSIGNMENT PLAN



Administrative Order 2017-38 modified this Court's Magistrate Judge Pairing Assignment Plan effective August 1, 2017, until further ordered. Administrative Orders 2018-65, 2019-5 and 2019-27 modified the Magistrate Judge Pairing Assignment Plan. Due to the recent confirmation of United States District Judge Rodolfo A. Ruiz, the Magistrate Judge Pairing Assignment Plan is amended as follows:

ORDERED that effective May 6, 2019, when Judge Ruiz begins receiving case transfers from other District Judges, he will be paired with Magistrate Judge Barry S. Seltzer for all Fort Lauderdale cases; Magistrate Judge Jacqueline Becerra for all Miami cases; and Magistrate Judge Bruce E. Reinhart for all West Palm Beach cases; it is

FURTHER ORDERED that all matters referred prior to May 6, 2019, shall be disposed of by the Magistrate Judge paired with the transferring District Judge irrespective of whether the motion is "ripe" or not. If the case is referred for all discovery matters or referred in full, the Magistrate Judge must complete the work necessary to rule on the pending matters before there is a referral to the Magistrate Judge paired with Judge Ruiz.
