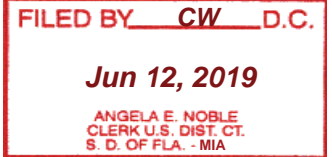

ORDER ON PETITION FOR REINSTATEMENT

THIS CAUSE is before the Court on attorney Phillip Jay Brutus's Petition for Reinstatement as a member of the Bar of this Court. Brutus was reciprocally disciplined by this Court based upon an Order of Suspension by the Supreme Court of Florida. *See* S.D. Fla. Admin. Order 2017-40. On March 19, 2018, Brutus filed a Petition for Reinstatement with The Florida Bar. After consideration of an uncontested Report of Referee and Stipulation for Summary Proceedings, the Supreme Court of Florida issued an Order of Reinstatement on October 16, 2018, reinstating Brutus as a member in good standing with The Florida Bar, subject to a two-year probationary period as set forth in the Report and Stipulation. *See The Florida Bar RE: Phillip J. Brutus*, No. SC18-424, 2018 WL 4999985 (Fla. Oct. 16, 2018).

Pursuant to Rule 12(c) of the Rules Governing the Admission, Practice, Peer Review, and Discipline of Attorneys, and upon consideration of the Petition, attachments to the Petition, and being otherwise fully advised in the matter, the Court finds that Brutus qualifies for reinstatement to this Court's Bar. Accordingly, the Court hereby GRANTS Brutus's Petition for Reinstatement and orders that he be reinstated as a member in good standing to the Bar of this Court.
