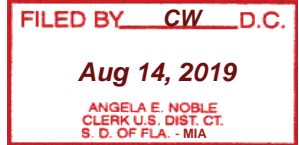

ORDER ON PETITION FOR REINSTATEMENT

THIS CAUSE is before the Court on attorney Adam Paul Philpott's Petition for Reinstatement as a member of the Bar of this Court. Philpott was reciprocally disciplined by this Court based upon an Order of Suspension by the Supreme Court of Florida. *See* Administrative Order 2016-71 and *The Florida Bar v. Philpott*, No. SC16-1519, 2016 WL 6462401 (Fla. Nov. 1, 2016). On December 17, 2018, Philpott filed a Petition for Reinstatement with The Florida Bar. After consideration of a report of the referee, the Supreme Court of Florida issued an Order of Reinstatement on August 8, 2019, reinstating Philpott as a member in good standing with The Florida Bar. *See The Florida Bar RE: Adam Paul Philpott*, No. SC18-2066, 2019 WL 3729789 (Fla. Aug. 8, 2019).

Pursuant to Rule 12(c) of this Court's Rules Governing the Admission, Practice, Peer Review, and Discipline of Attorneys, upon consideration of the Petition, attachments to the Petition, and being otherwise fully advised in the matter, the Court finds that Philpott qualifies for reinstatement to this Court's Bar. Accordingly, this Court GRANTS Philpott's Petition for Reinstatement and orders that he be reinstated as a member in good standing to the Bar of this Court.
