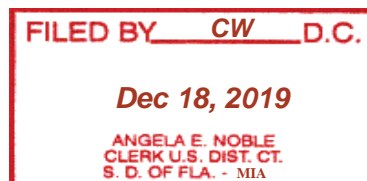

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2019-94

**IN RE:  
ADDITIONAL COURT CLOSURE  
DURING HOLIDAYS**

The President of the United States has entered an executive order closing all executive departments and agencies of the Federal Government and excusing federal employees from duty on Tuesday, December 24, 2019, the day before Christmas Day. Therefore, the Court finds it appropriate to amend the holiday schedule in effect for the Southern District of Florida as set forth in Administrative Order 2019-72. Accordingly, it is

**ORDERED and ADJUDGED** that in addition to the holiday schedule in effect pursuant to Administrative Order 2019-72, the Court will be closed for regular business on Tuesday, December 24, 2019.

The Duty Judge and Duty Magistrate Judge will be responsible for carrying out that judge's duties, and the rules regarding judicial emergencies will continue to apply.
