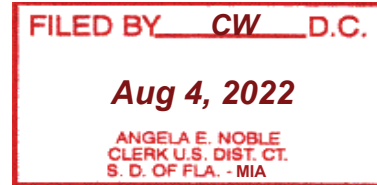

ORDER REQUESTING SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION


On May 21, 2022, the Court issued an Order to Show Cause, requesting that attorney John Parker Fenner show cause as to why he has not complied with the January 26, 2022 Order on Report and Recommendation, adopting the Ad Hoc Committee on Attorney Admissions, Peer Review, and Attorney Grievance's ("Committee[']s") Report and Recommendation. *See In re: John Parker Fenner*, S.D. Fla. Admin. Order No. 2022-13 (Jan. 26, 2022). Mr. Fenner submitted a Supplement to Response to May 2022 Report & Recommendation, dated July 18, 2022. In that response, Mr. Fenner states that he never received a copy of the Court's January 26 Order due to listing an incorrect mailing address, that he has contacted The Florida Bar's LOMAS and implemented a solo practice scheduling tool, and he has no federal cases pending since the initial Report and Recommendation.

Given this background, in accordance with Rule 6(c)(2)(A)(iii) of the Rules Governing the Admission, Practice, Peer Review, and Discipline of Attorneys, Local Rules of the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida,

IT IS ORDERED that the Committee shall submit a supplemental report and recommendation to the Court as to whether Mr. Fenner can attain an adequate level of competency by completing the obligations of the January 26, 2022 Order, whether he should be subject to any

additional obligations, or whether there is a substantial likelihood that his continued practice of law may result in serious harm to his clients in order to justify disciplinary proceedings.
