

Pursuant to the authority conferred by Title 28, United States Code, Section 631, and the authority granted in action taken by the Judicial Conference of the United States, it is

ORDERED that Panayotta Augustin-Birch is appointed as full-time United States Magistrate Judge at Fort Lauderdale, Florida, at an annual salary as fixed by the Judicial Conference of the United States. United States Magistrate Judge Panayotta Augustin-Birch commenced the performance of her duties on September 30, 2022, upon taking the oath or affirmation prescribed by Title 28, United States Code, Sections 453 and 631(g).
