ORDER ON PETITION FOR REINSTATEMENT

THIS CAUSE is before the Court on attorney Aubrey George Rudd's Petition for Reinstatement as a member of the Bar of this Court. Mr. Rudd was reciprocally disciplined by this Court based upon an Order of Suspension by the Supreme Court of Florida. *See The Florida Bar v. Rudd*, No. SC15-1506, 2016 WL 3450459 (Fla. June 23, 2016), and Administrative Order 2022-10. On November 18, 2020, Mr. Rudd filed a Petition for Reinstatement with the Florida Supreme Court. After consideration of an uncontested report of the referee, the Supreme Court of Florida issued an Order of Reinstatement on April 29, 2021, reinstating Mr. Rudd as a member in good standing of The Florida Bar. *See The Florida Bar Re: Rudd*, No. SC20-1700, 2021 WL 1691927 (Fla. April 29, 2021).

Pursuant to Rule 12(c) of the Rules Governing the Admission, Practice, Peer Review, and Discipline of Attorneys, Local Rules of the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida, upon consideration of the Petition and being otherwise fully advised, the Court finds that Mr. Rudd qualifies for reinstatement to this Court's Bar. Accordingly, this Court **GRANTS** Mr. Rudd's Petition for Reinstatement and orders that he be reinstated as a member in good

standing to the bar of this Court.
