

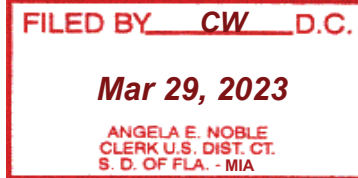

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2023-3

IN RE:

EXEMPTION OF FEES TO ACCESS PACER  
FOR LI HUANG

The United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida maintains case information online with the Public Access to Court Electronic Records (PACER) website. The Court desires to encourage the public's use of the database, continue to promote public access, and avoid unreasonable burdens on both users and court staff in retrieving data.

The Court finds that Li Huang, as an individual researcher associated with an educational institution, falls within the class of users listed in the fee schedule as being eligible for a fee exemption. Additionally, Ms. Huang has demonstrated that an exemption is necessary to avoid unreasonable burdens and to promote public access to information. Therefore, it is


**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that Li Huang is exempt from the payment of fees for access via PACER to the electronic case files maintained in this Court, to the extent such use is incurred in the course of her research on corporate prosecution and punishment. The list of selected cases in the Southern District of Florida is attached. The documents Ms. Huang will gather include, but are not limited to, indictments or complaints, plea agreements and statements of fact, judicial opinions and judgments, and sentencing memoranda. Ms. Huang is not exempt from the payment of fees incurred in connection with other uses of the PACER system in this Court. Additionally, the following limitations apply:

1. this fee exemption applies only to Li Huang and is valid only for the purposes stated above;

2. this fee exemption applies only to the electronic case files of this Court that are available through the PACER system;
3. by accepting this exemption, Ms. Huang agrees not to sell for profit any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption;
4. Ms. Huang is prohibited from transferring any data obtained as a result of receiving this exemption, including redistribution via internet-based databases; and
5. this exemption is valid from September 1, 2022, through December 31, 2023.

This exemption may be revoked at the discretion of the Court at any time. The Clerk of Court for the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida shall provide the PACER Service Center with any detailed information the Center may require to implement this Order.
