ORDER ON PETITION FOR REINSTATEMENT

THIS CAUSE is before the Court on Gregory Saldamando's Petition for Reinstatement as a member of the Bar of this Court. [ECF No. 5]. Mr. Saldamando was reciprocally disciplined by this Court following the Supreme Court of Florida's Order of Suspension. *See The Florida Bar v. Saldamando*, No. SC20-844, 2022 WL 963799 (Fla. Mar. 31, 2022) [ECF No. 1] and Administrative Order 2022-41 [ECF No. 4]. On March 9, 2023, the Supreme Court of Florida issued an Order of Reinstatement, reinstating Mr. Saldamando as a member in good standing of The Florida Bar. *See The Florida Bar Re: Saldamando*, No. SC2022-1019, 2023 WL 2440383 (Fla. Mar. 9, 2023) [ECF No. 5] Ex. 1.

Pursuant to Rule 12(c) of the Rules Governing the Admission, Practice, Peer Review, and Discipline of Attorneys, Local Rules of the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida; and upon consideration of the Petition and its exhibits, and being otherwise fully advised, the Court finds that Mr. Saldamando qualifies for reinstatement to this Court's Bar. Accordingly, the Court **GRANTS** Mr. Saldamando's Petition for Reinstatement and orders that he be reinstated as a member in good standing to the bar of this Court.
