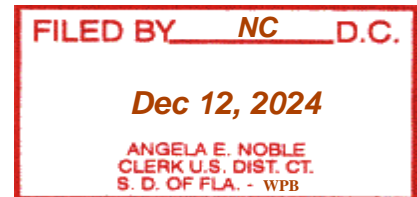

JONATHAN GOODMAN AS CHIEF
UNITED STATES MAGISTRATE JUDGE



According to the Court's Internal Operating Procedures, Section 4.02.00, the District Judges may select one full-time Magistrate Judge to serve as the Chief Magistrate Judge performing administrative functions. In March 1994, the Court established a schedule to rotate the position of Chief Magistrate Judge based on seniority. The term of Chief Magistrate Judge Edwin G. Torres will expire upon completion of his three-year term effective January 7, 2025. Magistrate Judge Jonathan Goodman is next in line of seniority. Accordingly, it is

ORDERED that effective January 7, 2025, Magistrate Judge Jonathan Goodman is hereby appointed Chief Magistrate Judge. Much to the Court's regret, it is also **ORDERED** that Magistrate Judge Goodman's appointment as Chief Magistrate Judge shall expire upon his retirement on July 25, 2025. Judge Goodman will be sorely missed by the entire Court family.
