ORDER ON VERIFIED PETITION FOR REINSTATEMENT

THIS CAUSE is before the Court on attorney Divya Khullar's Verified Petition for Reinstatement as a member of the Bar of this Court. [ECF No. 4]. The Court disciplined Mr. Khullar following the Supreme Court of Florida's Order of Suspension. *See The Florida Bar v. Khullar*, No. SC2022-0719, 2024 WL 964144 (Fla. March 6, 2024) [ECF No. 1]; Administrative Order 2024-37 [ECF No. 3]. On July 2, 2024, the Supreme Court of Florida issued an Order of Reinstatement, reinstating Mr. Khullar as a member in good standing of The Florida Bar. *See The Florida Bar v. Khullar*, No. SC2022-0719, 2024 WL 3274672 (Fla. July 2, 2024).

Under Rule 12(c) of the Rules Governing the Admission, Practice, Peer Review, and Discipline of Attorneys, Local Rules of the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida; and upon consideration of the Petition and its exhibits, the Court finds that Mr. Khullar qualifies for reinstatement to this Court's Bar. Accordingly, the Court **GRANTS** Mr. Khullar's Verified Petition for Reinstatement and orders that he be reinstated as a member in good standing to the bar of this Court.
