

## **ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2024-85**

IN RE: APPOINTMENT OF FEDERAL MAGISTRATE JUDGE MERIT SELECTION PANEL REGARDING UPCOMING REAPPOINTMENT OF MAGISTRATE JUDGE SHANIEK MILLS MAYNARD

All Panel members have been advised in writing of the restriction set forth in § 420.30.20(d) of the Regulations of the Judicial Conference of the United States Establishing Standards and Procedures for the Appointment and Reappointment of United States Magistrate Judges.

This Federal Magistrate Judge Merit Selection Panel and the term of each member shall expire on February 28, 2025, unless otherwise extended or modified by order of this Court.
