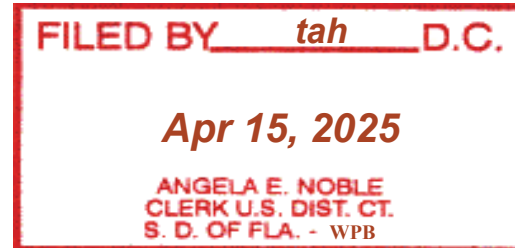

**ORDER OF DISBARMENT**

On March 13, 2025, The Supreme Court of Florida entered an Order granting Lisa Renee Wilcox’s uncontested Petition for Disciplinary Revocation with Leave to Apply for Readmission. *See In Re: Petition for Disciplinary Revocation of Wilcox*, No. SC2025-0093, 2025 WL 799292 (Fla. March 13, 2025) [ECF No. 1]. Disciplinary revocation is tantamount to disbarment under Rules 3-7.12 and 3-5.1(g) of the Rules Regulating The Florida Bar.

Under Rule 9(b) of the Rules Governing the Admission, Practice, Peer Review, and Discipline of Attorneys, Local Rules of the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida, attorneys who are disbarred on consent by the bar of any other court, while an investigation into allegations of misconduct is pending, are no longer allowed to practice before this Court and are stricken from the roll of attorneys admitted to practice before this Court until further order. *See id.* Consequently, under Rule 9(b) and the Court’s inherent authority to oversee officers admitted to membership in its bar, *see Chambers v. NASCO, Inc.*, 501 U.S. 32, 43 (1991) (noting “a federal court has the power to control admission to its bar and to discipline attorneys who appear before it” (citation omitted)), it is

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** as follows:


1. Ms. Wilcox is disbarred from practice in this Court, effective immediately. Ms.

Wilcox may not resume the practice of law before this Court until reinstated by order of the Court. *See* S.D. Fla. Att’y R. 12(a).

2. Ms. Wilcox shall advise the Clerk of Court of all pending cases before this Court in which she is counsel or co-counsel of record.
3. The Clerk of Court shall **STRIKE** Ms. Wilcox from the roll of attorneys eligible to practice in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida and shall also immediately revoke the attorney’s CM/ECF password.
4. The Clerk of Court shall attempt to serve by certified mail a copy of this Order of Disbarment on Ms. Wilcox at her court record and Florida Bar addresses.
