ORDER FOR PLACEMENT ON THE INACTIVE LIST

On May 29, 2025, the Supreme Court of Florida entered an Order [ECF No. 1] classifying attorney Carlos L. Santi as an inactive member under Rule 3-713 of the Rules Regulating the Florida Bar. *See Fla. Bar v. Santi*, No. 2025-0692, 2025 WL 1529132, at *1 (Fla. May 29, 2025). The Order followed Mr. Santi’s filing of a Joint Petition for Placement on the Inactive List [ECF No. 2].

Under Rule 11 of the Southern District of Florida’s Local Rules Governing the Admission, Practice, Peer Review, and Discipline of Attorneys (“Attorney Rules”), when the Court is advised “that an attorney has been . . . placed on inactive status or resigned, . . . , the Court, upon proper proof of the fact, shall enter an order immediately placing the attorney on the Court’s inactive list until further order of the Court.” *Id.* (alterations added). Consistent with Rule 11, service of an order to show cause is not required under these circumstances, and the attorney may be immediately placed on the inactive list without further proceedings.

Therefore, under Attorney Rule 11 and the Court’s inherent authority to oversee membership in its bar and safeguard the public interest, *see Chambers v. NASCO, Inc.*, 501 U.S. 32, 43 (1991) (citation omitted), it is

ORDERED as follows:

1. Mr. Santi is placed on the Court’s inactive list, effective immediately. He may not resume practice before this Court unless and until reinstated by court order. *See* Att’y Rule 12(a).
2. Within **fourteen (14) days** of receipt of this Order, Mr. Santi shall notify the Clerk of

Court of any active cases in which he appears as counsel or co-counsel of record in this District.

3. The Clerk is directed to **STRIKE** Mr. Santi from the roll of attorneys authorized to practice before this Court and to immediately revoke his CM/ECF credentials.

4. The Clerk shall promptly attempt service of this Order via certified mail to Mr. Santi's court record address and any addresses on file with The Florida Bar.
